**PILOTAGE**

As for Sydney, with the exception that the Pilot boarding ground is 3 miles East of Cape Solander.

**SERVICES OFFERED**

Sydney Harbour Control broadcasts navigational meteorological and tidal information, approximately 5 minutes past each hour, for both Sydney and Botany Bay.

**ANCHORING AND RESTRICTED AREAS**

No recommended anchorages off the Port but vessels usually anchor in Bate Bay or to the North of North Head (Off Sydney Harbour).

Anchoring is not permitted within the Port or within the restricted area described below.

Restricted Area: Bounded by a line 090° from Cape Banks and a line 180° from Cape Solander and a line centred on Henry Head Light radius 3 miles.

Leading Lights in line 312° divide the restricted area into two sectors:

Northern Sector C: INBOUND SHIPS ONLY  
Southern Sector D: OUTBOUND SHIPS ONLY
