Remote sensors all along the River Seine report visibility to Rouen Port Traffic. Information is then broadcast to ships. All vessels must contact Rouen Pilot (See Reports page URO 1). They will be given time Pilot will board or instructions to anchor. <p>No vessel may enter the fairway inshore from the compulsory pilotage line without permission from Rouen VTS.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2.
