

SERVICES OFFERED**Information service**

Situation reports (SITREP) are broadcast at fixed times, and reports to individual ships are broadcast on demand, in German and English, on VHF CH 67.

Time of SITREP: At 02.35 and every 2 hours between 06.35 and 22.35, on VHF CH 67.

Contents of SITREP:

1. Information relevant to the safe passage of the vessel through the VTS area
2. General fairway and traffic situation (e.g. weather conditions, casualties, dredging operations, pilot information)

Pilotage

1. Tankers carrying gas/chemicals/petroleum/petroleum products in bulk, or unloaded tankers if not cleaned, de-gassed, or completely inerted after carrying petroleum/petroleum products with flashpoint below 35°C.
2. All vessels exceeding 85 metres in length or 13metres beam or 5 metres in draught.
