Information service

Situation report at fixed times and individual reports on demand from VTS centre Trave Traffic CH 13.

Situation reports (SITREP) from 06.00 to 21.00 every 3 hours on VHF CH 13 given in German and English.

Contents of SITREP:

1. Information relevant to the safe passage of the vessel through the VTS area (e.g. right of way vessel movements in VTS Area).
2. General fairway and traffic situation (e.g. weather conditions, casualties, dredging operations, pilot information).

Navigational Assistance Service

Not provided in Trave VTS Area.

Traffic Organisation Service

Prevention of accidents, control of traffic flow by information, warning, advice or instruction.

Pilotage

Pilotage is compulsory for -

1. Tankers carrying gas/chemicals/petroleum/petroleum products in bulk, or unloaded tankers if not cleaned, de-gassed, or completely inerted after carrying petroleum/petroleum products with flashpoint below 35°C.
2. All vessels exceeding 60 metres in length or 10 metres beam or more.

BOARDING PLACE:

Near lightbuoy "Trave" off Travemünde.

ETA / ETD:

- Inbound at least 12 hours (confirmation exactly 2 hours, if possible) before arrival at boarding position and when passing lightbuoy "1" in Lübeck-Gedser route.

- Outbound: at least 2 hours before departure (departures 19.00 - 08.00: request pilot before 17.00).
