Information service

Situation reports (SITREP) are broadcast at fixed times, and reports to individual ships are broadcast on demand, in German and English on VHF CH 12.

Time of SITREP: At 02.30, 06.30, 09.30, 12.30, 15.30, 18.30 AND 21.30

Contents of SITREP:

1. Information relevant to the safe passage of the vessel through the VTS area
2. General fairway and traffic situation (e.g. weather conditions, casualties, dredging operations, pilot information)

Pilotage

Pilotage is compulsory for -

1. Tankers carrying gas/chemicals/petroleum/petroleum products in bulk, or unloaded tankers if not cleaned, de-gassed, or completely inerted after carrying petroleum/petroleum products with flashpoint below 35°C.
2. All vessels exceeding 90 metres in length or 13 metres beam.

Boarding Place:

1. Near lightbuoy 'Wismar' (vessels exceeding 90 metres in length or 5.2 metres draught)
2. Off Timmendorf pilot station (vessels not exceeding above dimensions)
3. Near lightbuoy "Offentief" (vessels not exceeding 3.1 metres draught)

ETA / ETD:

- Inbound at least 4 hours before arrival at boarding position.
- Outbound at least 3 hours before departure (departures 19.00 - 07.00: request pilot before 17.00).

GIVING: IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha, Hotel (ETA at boarding place), India, Oscar (draught in decimetres), Uniform (Beam and Gross Tonnage).
