

PILOTAGE

Pilotage is compulsory for:-

- a. All vessels of 3000 GT or over
- b. Vessels of 1000 GT or over which are
 - i. Proceeding to or from an approved petroleum wharf and container terminal, or
 - ii. Carrying dangerous cargoes of IMO Dangerous Goods Class 1, 2 or 3, or
 - iii. Proceeding to or from a Government mooring buoy
- c. All gas carriers for the carriage in bulk of any liquefied gas listed in 1993 IGC Code
- d. Other vessels of 300 GT or over which are unable to proceed with their own power, damaged, unseaworthy, restricted in maneuverability or in a dangerous condition
(NOTE: Pilot should be requested, through the agent, from Hong Kong Pilots Association)

SERVICES OFFERED

Navigation warnings broadcast on VHF CH 20, every hour +15 in Cantonese and +45 in English.

Weather messages broadcast on appropriate VTS Sector VHF Channel:

1. Visibility reports for Hong Kong and approaches, when visibility falls below 2 nautical miles. These are broadcast on receipt at VTS Centre and every hour +00 both in Chinese & English.
2. Information on the approach and passage of tropical cyclone. Vessels should maintain a continuous listening watch for broadcasts.
