<p>SECTOR: TOKYO WAN VTS Zone consists of one sector.</p> <p>VTS zone borders on 6 ports: Yokohama, Tokyo, Kawasaki, Chiba, Yokosuka and Kisarazu.</p> <p>VHF CH 16, 14, 13 and 22 Call TOKYO MARTIS on CH 16 or CH 13.</p> <p>Call URAGA Channel Pilot on CH 16.</p> <p>When transiting the system, all vessels of 50m and upward in length shall keep watch on CH 16.</p>	<p>PRE-ENTRY REPORT - ONE DAY IN ADVANCE Vessels shall report by noon of the day before the day of arrival. This requirement applies to vessels of 160m and over in length, vessels of 25,000 GRT and over carrying liquefied gas, towing or pushing vessels of 200m and over in total length.</p> <p>TO: TOKYO MARTIS GIVING: IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha, Bravo, Hotel, India, Lima, Oscar, Papa, Tango and Uniform VIA: AGENT or Telephone: 046-843-8622, 8623, 8624 or Yokohama Coast Guard Radio on VHF CH 16 or MF 2189.5 kHz or Sea-NACCS (Web)</p> <p>PRE-ENTRY REPORT - 3 HOURS IN ADVANCE Vessels carrying dangerous goods (except vessels which have submitted a Pre-Entry report) shall report DG items to TOKYO MARTIS at least 3 hours before entry into the traffic routes.</p> <p>CHANGE OF ETA Change of ETA exceeding 10 minutes should be notified to TOKYO MARTIS at least 3 hours before entry into the traffic routes.</p> <p>POSITION REPORT Vessels of 50m and over in length without AIS, should report their position to TOKYO MARTIS when passing the first Position Reporting Line. Traffic Organization Service, 3. Navigational Assistance Service as necessary. <p>Traffic and Safety information in English is broadcasted at 15 and 30 min. past every hour via MF 2019kHz.</p> <p>PILOTAGE Pilotage is compulsory for all vessels of 10,000 GRT and over.</p> <p>Pilotage is recommended for vessels commanded by masters without sufficient experience in the area and for foreign vessels.</p> <p>Pilot boards at 178° about 2.2 miles from URAGA Suido Traffic Route Mid Light Buoy No.1 (See Page TYB 2).</p> <p>Notify change of ETA to URAGA CHANNEL PILOT via Agent or VHF CH16.</p>
