

NAVIGATION RULES

5. Designated Tracks outside the Traffic Routes

The tracks described in the Navigation Regulations shall be used by all vessels not navigating in a Traffic Route (see right).

6. Destination information on AIS

Vessels navigating in the VTS area shall transmit the AIS code for their destination port in order to inform other vessels of their route.

SERVICES AND NAVIGATION REGULATION

② *Tokyo Wan Aqua Line East Waterway (See TYB-5)*

- (i) Southbound vessels through the Tokyo Wan Aqua Line East Waterway shall:
- navigate to the west of **Line A**;
 - navigate close to **Line A** when approaching from Chiba; and
 - navigate away from **Line A** when approaching from Tokyo.
- (ii) Northbound vessels through the Tokyo Wan Aqua Line East Waterway shall:
- navigate to the east of **Line A**;
 - navigate away from **Line A** when navigating towards Chiba; and
 - navigate close to **Line A** when navigating towards Tokyo.

③ *Kisarazu Ko Offing Light Buoy (See TYB-6)*

Vessels navigating in the vicinity of the northern gateway of Naka-no-Se traffic route which cross **Line B** after crossing **Line A** shall keep Kisarazu Ko Offing Light Buoy on the port side.

④ *Nakanose West Sea Area (See TYB-6)*

- (i) Southbound vessels navigating through the western sea area of Naka-no-Se in Tokyo Wan should navigate to the west of **Line A**.
- (ii) Northbound vessels navigating through the western sea area of Naka-no-Se in Tokyo Wan (excluding vessels navigating to the west of **Line B**) should:
- navigate in the area to the east of **Line A** until altering their course to the destination port;
 - navigate more than 400 meters off **Line C** when their draft is 20m or more.
