<p>SECTOR:</p> <p>YOKOHAMA VTS Zone consist of one sector.</p> <p>VHF CH 16 and 12.</p> <p>Call YOKOHAMA Harbour Coast Guard Radio for change of Sailing Plan and call KEIHIN Harbour Radar for Information Service on CH 16.</p> <p>Call YOKOHAMA Port Radio for Pilotage and Port Services on CH 16.</p> <p>Call YOKOHAMA Coast Guard Radio for Emergency Contact on CH 16.</p> <p>When transiting the system, all vessels should keep watch on CH 16.</p>	<p>PRE-ENTRY REPORTS – ONE DAY IN ADVANCE</p> <p>Vessels as below shall report by noon of the day before the day of arrival or departure.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Vessels of 160 m and over in length (as for oil tankers, 1,000 GRT and over) entering Yokohama Passage. Vessels of 1,000 GRT and over entering Tsurumi or Kawasaki Passage. <p>TO: Captain of the Port (YOKOHAMA Area of KEIHIN Port)</p> <p>GIVING: IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha Bravo Golf Hotel (ETA at passage) India (berth) Juliet (including tugs) Kilo (ETD from berth or anchorage) Oscar Papa (kind and quantity) Uniform (GRT)</p> <p>VIA: AGENT or YOKOHAMA Harbour Coast Guard Radio on CH 16 or Yokohama Coast Guard office as for Yokohama Passage - Tel: 045 621 5957 and Tsurumi Passage - Tel: 044 277 0946.</p> <p>Change of Sailing Plan</p> <p>Change of any sailing plan mentioned above, should be notified to Agent, YOKOHAMA Harbour Coast Guard Radio immediately.</p>	<p>Services</p> <p>KEIHIN Harbour Radar provides;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Information Service Traffic Organization Service. <p>Maritime Safety Information is broadcasted from 42 to 52 minutes on every hour during 0600 to 1900 JST.</p> <p>Pilotage</p> <p>Pilotage is compulsory for vessels of 3,000 GRT and over, and 300 GRT and over carrying dangerous cargo.</p> <p>Pilotage is recommended for vessels commanded by masters without sufficient experience in the area and for all foreign vessels.</p> <p>Pilot boarding points, see Page YOK 2; Point A: bound for Tsurumi Passage, Point B: bound for Yokohama Passage, Point C: bound for Negishi or for Section 5.</p> <p>Notify change of ETA via agent or directly to YOKOHAMA Port Radio on VHF CH 16.</p> <p>Anchorage</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Vessels of 500 GRT and over must obtain permission from the Captain of the Port before anchoring. Permission or designation of berth or anchorage is required for vessels carrying dangerous goods.
