

REPORTS (2)**INCIDENT REPORTS**

Any of the following must be immediately reported to Roca Control:

- (1) Fire or explosion
- (2) Any condition that may impair a vessel's ability to safely navigate and manoeuvre.
- (3) Involvement in a marine casualty
- (4) Any pollution incident
- (5) Any hazard to navigation
- (6) Any defect or discrepancy in an Aid to Navigation
- (7) Adverse weather or visibility conditions
- (8) Another vessels in apparent difficulty
- (9) Security incidents.

OTHER INFORMATION**TRAFFIC SURVEILLANCE**

Radar and radio communications monitoring is maintained with Roca Control area for the provision of Vessel Traffic Services.

INFORMATION BROADCASTS

(1) Roca Control broadcasts navigational, meteorological and traffic information on VHF Ch 22 and Ch 79 and AIS when appropriate.
