<p>Vladivostok VTS is an integrated part of the Peter the Great Bay VTS (see PGB1 & PGB2).</p> <p>Vladivostok VTS area consists of the two Sectors (see VVO 2):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sector 3 – Port of Vladivostok with approaches; - Sector 4 – Slavyanka Port with approaches. <p>The VTS provides an Information Service, Navigational Assistance Service and Traffic Organization Service.</p> <p>VHF CH 67</p> <p>CALL SIGN: VLADIVOSTOK TRAFFIC</p> <p>Telephone: +7 4232 49 84 00</p> <p>Fax: +7 4232 49 84 38</p> <p>E-mail: vts.vldv@norfes.ru</p> <p>Clearances to move or to anchor must be obtained from the VTS.</p> <p>Vessels of more than 50 m in length must proceed along the fairways. The maximum speed within the port harbours is nine (9) knots.</p>	<p>Vessels under way must keep a continuous radio watch on VHF CH 67.</p> <p>Vessels at anchor must keep a continuous watch on VHF CH 16.</p> <p>Permission to cease VHF watch or to change a VHF channel must be obtained from the VTS.</p> <p>PRE-ENTRY REPORT</p> <p>TO: Ship's agent</p> <p>Time and content of report must be in accordance with Port Regulations.</p> <p>ENTRY REPORT</p> <p>TO: VLADIVOSTOK TRAFFIC</p> <p>GIVING: IMO SRS Items: Alpha, Charlie or Delta, Echo, Foxtrot</p> <p>WHEN: Entering the VTS Area (see VVO 2)</p> <p>VIA: VHF CH 67</p> <p>MOVEMENT REPORT</p> <p>On crossing the boundary between Sectors 3 & 4 (see VVO 2)</p> <p>DEPARTURE REPORT</p> <p>TO: VLADIVOSTOK TRAFFIC</p> <p>GIVING: IMO SRS Items: Alpha, India (port of destination), Oscar, Papa, Tango, Whiskey, X-Ray (Port Clearance No.)</p> <p>WHEN: Not less than 15 minutes before departing the berth or anchorage.</p> <p>VIA: VHF CH 67</p>	<p>Pilotage is compulsory for all foreign vessels:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – within the Valdivostok Port area; – within the inner harbour area of Slavyanka Port. <p>PILOT BOARDING GROUND</p> <p>In the anchorage areas or at the entry to the compulsory pilotage areas.</p>
