PRE ENTRY REPORTS

Not less than 24 hours before arrival at port

TO: CAPTAIN OF THE PORT
GIVING: IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha Golf India
VIA: AGENT
NOTE:

1. Applies to ALL vessels of 1600 GT and over
2. Vessel on voyage of less than 24 hrs must report before departing United States port
3. Report must be updated if ETA changes by more than 6 hours

15 minutes before entering VTS Zone (inbound or outbound)

Entry report

TO: NEW YORK TRAFFIC
GIVING: IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha Charlie or Delta
WHEN: At VTS perimeter, departing berth or anchorage
VIA: Appropriate Sector VHF CH (CH 12/14)

MOVEMENT REPORTS

TO: NEW YORK TRAFFIC
GIVING: IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha Charlie or Delta
WHEN: Directed by VTS
VIA: Appropriate Sector VHF CH (CH 12/14)

DEVIATION REPORT

TO: NEW YORK TRAFFIC
GIVING: IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha India X-ray
WHEN: Significant change from previously reported information, deviating from VTS direction
VIA: Appropriate Sector VHF CH (CH 12/14)

FINAL REPORT

TO: NEW YORK TRAFFIC
GIVING: IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha Charlie or Delta
WHEN: Making fast alongside, anchoring, departing VTS Zone
VIA: Appropriate Sector VHF CH (CH 12/14)

ALL TIMES IN LOCAL TIME

Any of the following conditions should be immediately reported to the VTS:

1. any defect or discrepancy in an aid to navigation
2. involvement in a marine casualty
3. any pollution incident
4. any condition that may impair a vessels ability to safely navigate or manoeuvre

Examples

- a) defective propulsion machinery, steering gear, navigation equipment, communication equipment
- b) fire, explosion, grounding, leaking, illness of a person, or manning shortage
- c) cargo arrangement, trim, loaded condition, underkeel clearance
- d) deficiencies in respect to current nautical charts and publications
5. any hazard to navigation
6. adverse weather condition including any reduction in visibility

VIA: Appropriate VHF Sector frequency

SERVICES OFFERED

1. **NEW YORK TRAFFIC** issues advisories and provides on request, the following information:
 - a) traffic
 - b) local weather
 - c) aids to navigation status
 - d) local harbour operations such as ferry routes or dredging
 - e) anchorage availability
